- **(6) = Proposal Awaiting Review by RAIN Board and BDRs that will result in legislation needing RAIN Board scrutiny**

Summary of Priority Bills (i.e. those with a (6), (1), or (5) designation)

- **Revenue/Budget**
 - AB 561 (1): AN ACT relating to governmental financial administration; delaying the commencement of certain transfers to the Fund to Stabilize the Operation of the State Government; revising the provisions governing the rate and calculation of the payroll tax imposed on certain businesses other than financial institutions; requiring the deposit of certain fees imposed on the short-term lease of passenger cars into the State General Fund; extending the prospective expiration of certain requirements regarding the imposition and advance payment of certain taxes and fees; requiring the transfer of money from the Fund to Stabilize the Operation of the State Government to the State General Fund; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
- **Children/Family Issues**
 - AB 154 (1): Enacts provisions which guarantee certain rights to children placed in foster homes in this State
 - SCR 5 (1): Directs the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study concerning the laws of this State governing the protection of children. (BDR 364)
- **Criminal Justice, Reentry/Corrections/Other.**
 - AB 6 (1): *Authorizes courts to allow certain victims of sex trafficking or involuntary servitude who have been convicted of engaging in or soliciting prostitution to seek new trials and have their judgments of conviction vacated.*
 - AB 92 (1): *Provides for the waiver of fees for the issuance of certain forms of identifying information for certain persons released from prison.*
 - AB 93(1): *Provides for the establishment of intermediate sanction facilities within the Department of Corrections to provide treatment for alcohol or drug abuse to certain probation violators and offenders*
 - AB 134 (1): Prohibits the imposition of a sentence of life imprisonment without the possibility of parole upon a juvenile offender convicted of a non-homicide crime
 - AB 301 (1): Revises provisions governing the restoration of civil (voting) rights for ex-felons
 - AB 501 (1): Provides for a study of fiscal issues regarding the death penalty. (BDR 1103)
 - SB 159 (1): Makes various changes governing offenders(contains RAIN amendment requiring DOC to provide assistance to offenders wanting IDs upon release)
- **Health Care Issues**
 - *AB 137 (1) (R1): *Revises provisions governing programs of nutrition in public schools. (BDR 34-191) Note: See Amendment*
- **Housing/Human Dignity (Wages)/Homelessness**
- **Other**
